REFLECTIONS

Introduction to the Liturgy of the Word

Isaiah 49:3, 5-6	From my mother's womb, I am God's servant.
Psalms 40	"Here am I, Lord; I come to do your will.
1 Corinthians 1:1-3	Greetings to you, a holy people in Christ.
John 1:29-34	Behold, the Lamb of God!

Isaiah, Paul, and John the Baptist were each called by God for a special purpose. Isaiah tells us of being called to reach out first to the exiled people of Israel and then to all nations. Paul tells the Corinthians that he was called to be an apostle. John was called to make Jesus known by baptizing with water. Now it is our turn to listen for God's call. Then we can respond, as we do in today's Psalm, "Here am I, Lord; I come to do your will."

ONE MINUTE MEDITATION

Well-placed faith

Our world is filled with pain, sorrow, and suffering. Putting our faith in worldly powers guarantees disappointment. Putting faith in God guarantees that we will never be disappointed.

"Lord, now lettest thou thy servant depart in peace, according to thy word; for mine eyes have seen thy salvation which thou hast prepared in the presence of all peoples, a light for revelation to the Gentiles, and for glory to thy people Israel" (Luke 2:29-32)

QUESTION OF THE WEEK

Am I willing to serve those who are not of my own tribe, as did Jesus, as did Isaiah, Paul, and John the Baptist?

WHY ARE WE REQUIRED TO RESPECT JESUS' NAME?

As the Son of God, Jesus' name is "above every name" (Philippians 2:9) and commands respect.

It is the name God gave Himself when He became man (Luke 1:31). In Jesus' day, there was no internet, no media, no network to use to find out if someone was reputable or reliable. All people had their good name and the way others used it with respect. He knew He would need a recognizable name.

FEAST & CELEBRATION

Jan. 20 – St. Fabian (250). During his long reign as pope, Fabian organized Rome into seven districts, countered a heresy in Africa, and founded churches in France. He was martyred during the Decian persecutions.
