## REFLECTIONS

### Introduction to the Liturgy of the Word

**Isaiah 8:23-9:3** “The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light.”

**Psalms 27** “The Lord is my light and my salvation.”

**1 Corinthians 1:10-13, 17** Let there be no divisions among you.

**Matthew 4:12-23** Andrew and Peter abandon their nets to follow the Lord.

The road on which we walk is one of dramatic change. Isaiah preaches about darkness and distress being replaced by light and rejoicing. Paul encourages his divided audience to unite in the name of Jesus. In Matthew, Jesus calls the first apostles and they leave their way of life and follow Him. As we listen to today's readings, notice how people are changed by the Light of the World.

### THE COMMON CALL

#### MATTHEW 4:12-23,

This Gospel passage recounts the call of the first disciples. They may not have known Jesus personally at first, but they knew about Him through John the Baptist (John 1:35-42). When invited to know Jesus better and follow Him closely, the men dropped what they were doing “at once” and left everything behind.

Under Christ's leadership, the disciples went on to do amazing things. They worked miracles, brought the Gospel to distant lands, converted countless souls for heaven, and suffered hardships, even martyrdom. The secret of their success was their relationship with Christ as their God, Savior, Teacher, and Friend who promised to be with them always (Matthew 28:20).

### WHY ARE WE REQUIRED TO

#### RESPECT JESUS' NAME?

#### (CONTINUED)

#### **Jesus' name tells us of His mission.**

The angel Gabriel appeared to Joseph in a dream and told Him to name the child “Jesus,” “for He will save His people from their sins” (Matthew 1:21). And He did.

#### **There is great power in Jesus' name.**

Jesus promised His disciples that whatever they asked in His name, He would do (John 14:14). In His name, the Apostles cast out demons (Luke 10:17), cured the sick, and even raised the dead (Acts 3:16; 4:10). “*There is no other name under heaven by which we must be saved*” (Acts 4:12).
